
P/1 MISS COULTHARD

Rosedale Foodbank

HI, WE ARE CHRISTINE AND ALAN BALL AND WE RUN THE LOCAL FOODBANK IN ROSEDALE. AFTER A TALK WITH EMMA FROM FOODBANK VICTORIA, WE THOUGHT WE'D GIVE YOU A FEW DETAILS OF OUR SERVICE TO SHARE WITH THE COMMUNITY. MANY OF OUR NEWER CLIENTS ADVISE THEY DID NOT KNOW WE EXIST EVEN THOUGH WE HAVE BEEN IN ROSEDALE WELL OVER A YEAR.

WE ARE LOCATED AT 48 QUEEN STREET, ROSEDALE WHERE WE RENT THE UNITING CHURCH HALL AND OPEN EVERY WEDNESDAY 10AM TILL 1PM. WE DO NOT CLOSE OVER CHRISTMAS AND THE NEW YEAR AND HOPE TO OPEN A SECOND DAY NEXT YEAR. ALL OUR VOLUNTEERS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A WORKING WITH CHILDREN CLEARANCE.

THERE ARE NO REQUIREMENTS FOR PEOPLE TO USE THE FOODBANK, INITIALLY WE ASK FOR A PENSION CARD, BUT THIS IS NOT A REQUIREMENT. WE ASK FOR A \$10 DONATION AND FOR THIS OFFER A SELF-SELECTED BAG OF GROCERIES AND IN ADDITION BREAD, FRUIT, AND VEGETABLES. WE HAVE A FAIRLY GOOD RANGE OF ITEMS FUNDED FROM THE \$10 DONATION AND ANY OTHER FUNDS THAT WE ATTRACT. SUPPLY IS MAINLY FROM FOODBANK VICTORIA - FROM A LIST OF AVAILABLE ITEMS ON A DAY-TO-DAY BASIS. BREAD FROM THE OLD ROSEDALE BAKERY, BANJOS IN TRARALGON AND MANY LOCAL INDIVIDUALS AND BUSINESSES GIVE US THEIR SURPLUS VEGGIES ETC.

ALTHOUGH BASED IN ROSEDALE WE HAVE PEOPLE FROM THE SURROUNDING AREAS OF HEYFIELD, GORMANDALE EVEN AS FAR
AS YARRAM AND SALE. TO COVER THE COST OF FUEL MANY OF OUR REGULARS SHARE A CAR.

WE ARE NOT A SUPERMARKET AND CANNOT SUPPLY ALL A FAMILY'S REQUIREMENTS BUT IF WE CAN REDUCE A FAMILY SHOPPING BILL BY WELL OVER \$50 PER WEEK THEN IT CAN HELP IMPROVE THEIR LIFESTYLE AND, IN SOME CASES, HELP WITH THEIR FINANCIAL SITUATION SO THAT THEY CAN GET OUT OF DIFFICULTY OR AVOID IT IN THE FIRST PLACE.

IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO SEE OUR OPERATION, WE ARE NORMALLY THERE BEFORE 9AM TO SET UP BUT IT IS PROBABLY BEST TO AVOID THE INITIAL RUSH 10 TO 11.
